Trends We Expect to Impact the Library



Millennials and Gen Z are the most diverse generations – Gen Z first in US where more than half are not White



Half of Gen Z are adults and prefer imagery (Instagram), video (YouTube & TikTok) and curating their own experiences (Netflix, Disney+, Hulu, YouTube)
