Title Level Access to Electronic Resources

Subscribed to Serials Solutions from 2003 to 2014

Used perl script created by John Wynstra for brief bib creation Loaded new brief bibs approximately every two months Added item records to add consistency to display

Added III's ERM in 2009


Brief bibs automatically created during Coverage Load Coverage Load completed at least once/semester Removed item records for electronic resources; checkins displayed instead

(Tried III's CASE in place of Serials Solutions in 2009; went back to Serials Solutions the next year)

Problems with Brief Bib Records

- Only title, ISSN, and holdings for electronic serials
- Only title and ISBN for ebooks
- No subject headings
- No notes
- No publication information
- For ebooks, no author or edition information
- Not very discoverable

Full MARC Records for Electronic Collections

Serials Solutions 360 MARC Updates

- Good records, but very expensive
- Not OCLC

Publisher-provided sets

- Frequently not cataloged to US standards
- Not OCLC

OCLC WorldCat Collection Sets

- Not available for all collections
- Sometimes very expensive



Why OCLC?

- OCLC member library since 1978
- Ongoing commitment as a member library to contribute all holdings to WorldCat, including electronic holdings
- Desire to have records for everything marked as held by Mossey Library in WorldCat also in the catalog
- Known, tested, and ever-improving quality of bibliographic data
- Largest store of bibliographic data in the world
- Consistent match points



OCLC Knowledge Base

- Introduced 2014
- Free to OCLC member libraries
- Full A-Z listing of collection holdings, maintained by OCLC staff in cooperation with publishers, and by member libraries (it's semi-crowdsourced)
- Automatic updating of holdings on associated WorldCat title-level bib records for all titles in held collections
- Daily delivery of MARC records for new, changed, and deleted bib records in held collections
- In addition to subscription collections, includes holdings of several public domain collections, including HaithiTrust

Why We Moved from Serials Solutions to the OCLC KB

- It's free! (Well, no more than we pay anyway.)
- OCLC staff did initial load of holdings based on Serials Solutions report—we didn't have to do it ourselves.
- We could FINALLY get full MARC records for the majority of our ejournal and ebook holdings for no extra cost. (Some titles in most collections do not yet have matching WorldCat cataloging.)
- Our title-level holdings would be set in WorldCat.
- Serials Solutions prices were going up—again.




Problems with the Move from Serials Solutions


- Steep learning curve—had to create a new process for getting records in and out of the catalog on a regular basis
- Growing but not yet complete and not always accurate coverage in the Knowledge Base
- Disconnect between the way we intended to use the data and the way
 the data was structured to be used (OCLC created Knowledge Base to
 support WorldCat Discovery, not for use with a third-party ERM like III's;
 bib records with URLs work fine, but URLs are not always delivered with
 holdings data, for instance)




Selecting Collections in the KB



Viewing Collection




Collection Settings






Downloading Holdings

Mossey Procedures (as they now stand)

- Serials Librarian maintains collection selection in KB
- Systems/Catalog Librarian downloads MARC records daily
 - Serial and monographic (ebook, escore, evideo, erecording) records delivered in separate files
 - New and Deleted records files downloaded; Updated record files not currently downloaded
 - New monographic records uploaded as is to Sierra
 - New serial records modified in MARCEdit to add local ejournal material type and add 222 duplicating \$a and \$p of 245 (used in local catalog for journal title search) before uploading to Sierra
 - Process for Deleted records still being developed
- Coverage loads done resource-by-resource
 - Serials Librarian does serials; Systems/Catalog Librarian will do monographs

Complications with Coverage Load

- Proxy information can be delivered on MARC records in 856 links, but cannot be included in KBART file for holdings; in order for WAM proxied links to be included in checkin records soft-linked to resource records, the proxy information has to be added to each downloaded KBART file
- If OCLC uses a formula for creating URLs for a resource, the KBART file does not include a URL at all; these URLs have to be added to the downloaded KBART files in order to create links in soft-linked checkin records
- Titles that are merely "indexed" in collections, and are not available in full-text, are delivered in KBART files for those collections; those titles have to be removed to avoid having coverage loaded for titles that are not really held

Disasters Encountered Along the Way

- Don't forget: Deleted records CANNOT be recovered.
 - In the process of trial and error for loading records from OCLC, Maurine accidentally deleted all checkin records not updated in the past year. Oops.
 - We could have paid III to restore the records, but new staff and non-serial staff combined did not realize soon enough that that was necessary
 - Serials staff worked for weeks to restore records (some clean-up did get done, on the plus side)
- Creating a new procedure took a lot longer than we expected
 - Staff illnesses and surprise gift collections diverted staff attention, too



Problems We're Still Trying to Solve

- Deleted records
 - OCLC provides files of records for which holdings are being deleted
 - Can load using Review Files and delete batch
 - BUT some have holdings for other packages attached, too
 - AND some are reinstated before we actually get around to the delete process
- Updated records
 - OCLC also provides files of updated records
 - Could easily overlay
 - BUT there are lots and lots of them
- Need to find a way to load coverage more often, and in larger batches
 - III Knowledge Base may end up being helpful here










A Current Plus to all the Extra Records

- Null hit searches are taking up to a minute in our WebPAC currently (reported issue)
- Having so many titles in the catalog greatly reduces the chances of a null result





Title Search

Type the title you want to find, then press the Enter key or click Search.

Search for: cold day in paradise

Sort by: System Sorted ▼

Type as much or as little of the title as you want. For example:

- · the merchant of venice
- · merchant of v
- merchant

The following initial articles will be automatically removed from a title search in this catalog: a, an, the, le, la, l', les un, une, der, das, ein, eine, il, una, el.

To search for titles that begin with one of the omitted articles used not as an article, but as a word or name (for example, in the titles El Dorado, and La Fontaine and his friends), add an additional "a" to your search, for example

- a el dorado
- · a la fontaine and his friends
