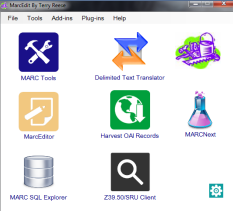

Using a load table, Excel, and MarcEdit to batch change email address in patron records

Goal of this Session: Show an example of a workflow that can be used in changing a single field on a big batch of records without overwriting other fields in the record.

Assumption: You have gone through Load Profile Training.



A Problem of CASE

Placing a hold on an Overdrive title in Encore has a bug.
Email address in UPPER CASE will result in an invalid
email message.

SOLUTION

1. Export patron records and use **Excel** to change the case from upper to lower.
2. Use **MarcEdit** to convert the file into MARC format and map the data into the corresponding field in the patron record.
3. Import the MARC file using a **modified load table** that will match on the patron record # and protect all fixed and variable fields, except the email address.

- @ov_protect to protect the fields. You have to make sure all the fields are protected.
- @ov_action="u" Reject 0, or 2. Overlay if match 1 record (use in tandem with @ldx)
- @ldx="907" Match on the record #. Overlays on the record # if stored in a MARC tag.

**@ov_protect="p=F43-56,83,95-96,99,101-105,
122-126,160,163,263,268V=cr4!'8denahtpumbxg**

Protect Patron records

"p=

Protects Fixed-length fields

F43-56,83,95-96,99,101-105,122-126,160,163,263,268

Protects Variable-length fields

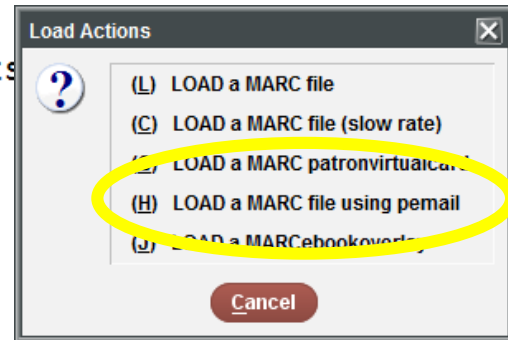
V=cr4!'8denahtpumbxg



Go to Edit .MARCLOAD.LOCAL file to create the load button.

**H > LOAD a MARC file using pemail | |marc2inn

Preparing the patron records.

1. Change only “active” records. Accounts less than 6 months expired and newer.
2. Clean up records - Fix email address that don't have an @ sign, or the “z” tag used for other data.



Use Excel to change the data

Excel Functions:

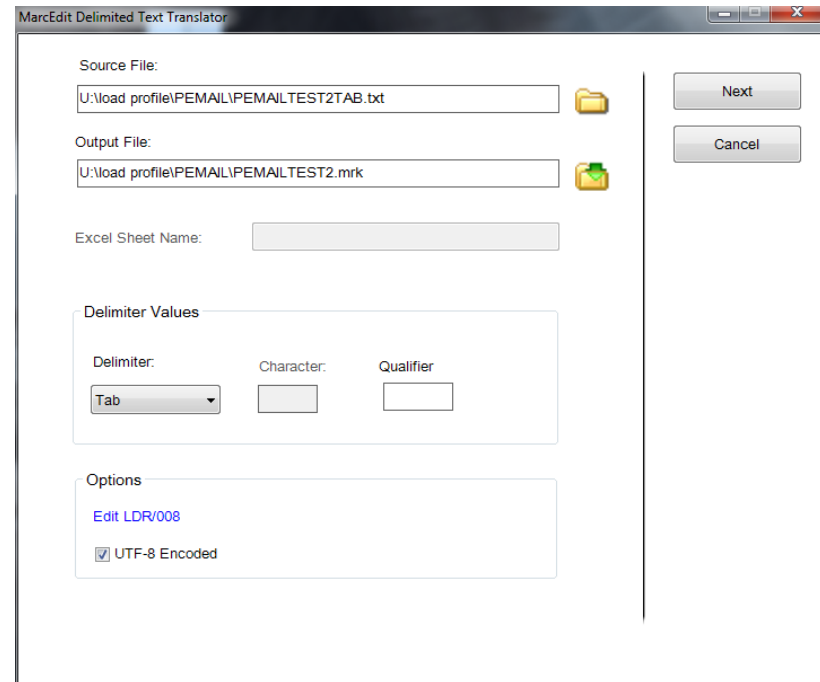
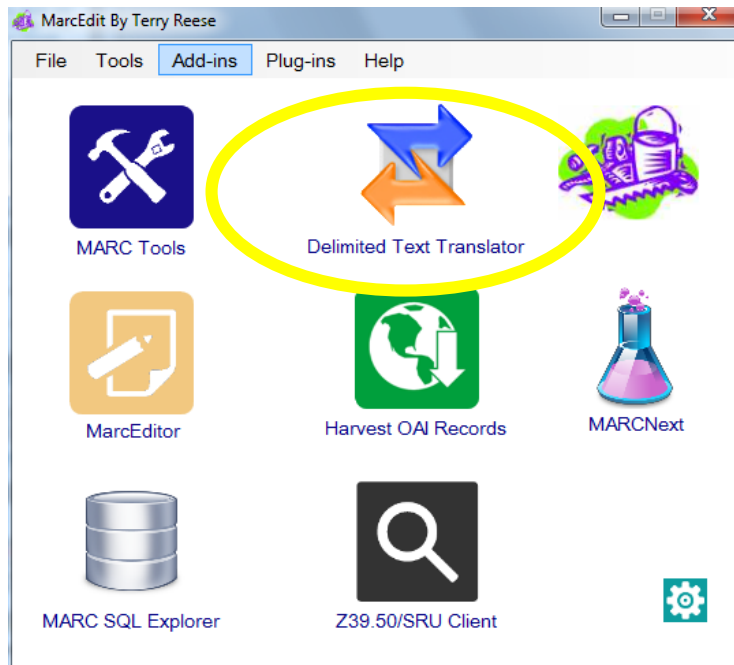
1.Exact – to sort by case – use this formula
`=MIN(--EXACT(A1:A25,LOWER(A1:A25)))=0`

2.Concatenate – to add “.” before the pXXXXX

3.Lower – to change email address from
UPPERCASE to lowercase



Use MarcEdit |Tab Delimited text to change the text file to .mrk file.



Map the two fields.

Then use MARCEDIT | MARCMaker to change .mrk file into a .mrc file.

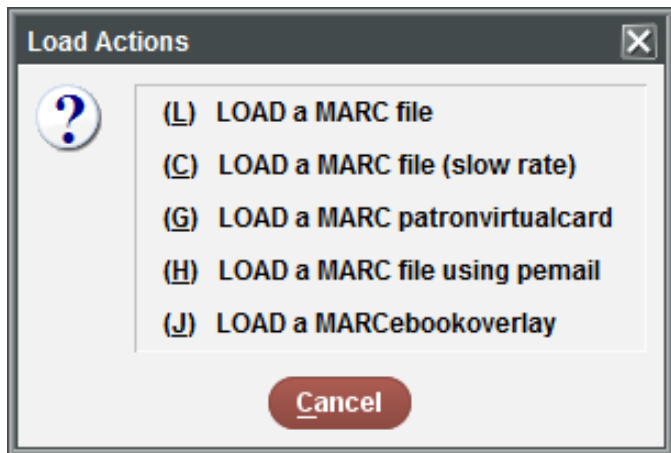

Best Practices

1. Modify a Load Table if you've had Load Profile Training.
2. Test! Use old or expired records before working on active records.
3. Check fields before and after a load. Get a sample and print it out.
